1. Reminder to Parents - Considerate Parking Around School

We have received messages from local residents regarding ongoing issues with parking during school drop-off and pick-up times. We kindly ask all parents and carers to be mindful of where they stop their vehicles.

Please do not block driveways, entrances, or exits, and avoid stopping in the middle of the road with hazard lights on. Instead, take a moment to pull over safely and considerately to allow your child to exit the car, ensuring that you are not obstructing access for our neighbours.

2. Reminder: Procedure for Students Feeling Unwell During the School Day

We would like to kindly remind you of the procedure for students who are feeling unwell during the school day. If your child is unwell, they should not contact you directly. Instead, they are expected to attend their lesson and inform the teacher of how they are feeling. The teacher will then use their professional judgment to assess the situation and determine if the student needs to see the school nurse.

If the nurse assesses the student and determines that they should go home, parents will be contacted at that point.

We appreciate your cooperation in reinforcing this procedure with your child, as it ensures that we can address their needs in a timely and appropriate manner.
