Message from Mr Loney

On behalf of all of our staff, we would like to wish a sincere well done to all of the students who have undergone a number of GCSE exams this week. Everything so far seems to be running largely seamlessly. The general feeling so far is that the papers have offered a fair and reasonable challenge, which are hoping will continue. It has become apparent that the year group have prepared well and have set themselves up to do very well in the remainder of the exams.

Please be reminded that students will not be permitted to wear hoodies, tracksuit tops or coats in the exam hall and that full Birchwood uniform must be worn. Please also confirm that your child has the necessary equipment for each of their exams as we cannot reliably have spares available.

All students are expected to be in school until May half term, which is rapidly approaching, then are welcome to only attend school for their exams. Please let me, Miss Adams, relevant form tutor or teacher know of anything that we can do to help over the last weeks.

Student Leave Information:

All students are expected back in school until the start of May half-term on Friday 23rd May. It is incredibly important that, for the outset of exams, the students have the consistent routine that they have had throughout their time here and access to that support network.

Students return from half term on Monday 2nd June and from this date need only attend for their exams. All students are welcome to attend school as usual, meet their teachers or make use of other facilities if preferred. A large number of subjects will be offering breakfast revision sessions. We are working to centralise this, but it is likely that individual subjects will be recording these on Satchel/Teams and letting students know in lessons, so please check these avenues.

Exam Procedure Information

With the exam season now in full swing, we would like to take this opportunity to remind you of some important information regarding exam procedures:

Uniform

All students should attend their exams in full uniform - this morning we had a small number of students who did not attend in uniform and we had to make arrangements to provide them with school items.

To avoid delay to entering the exam hall and any potential embarrassment, we would appreciate it if you could remind your child that uniform is a requirement of all exams.

Writing on skin

A small number of students have attended exams with writing on their skin. Please note, the JCQ exam regulations advise us that this is not allowed even if the writing is not related to the exam. Again, please could you reminder your child about this.

Attendance to lessons

As previously outlined, there is no formal exam leave until half term and we expect all students to be in lessons for the next two weeks, unless they have an exam. Maximising the time with teacher contact is vital to support students - it is a growing trend nationally for schools to retain students in school until all their exams are completed. We feel that retaining students until half term in lessons is a good balance for our students.

Due to safeguarding reasons we are not permitted to allow students to leave the school site before 3:10pm unless parents have contacted the school to request leave following the normal absence channels by either using the Arbor reporting app or contacting our Reception desk admin@birchwoodhigh.org.uk directly. Please note, individual teachers should not be contacted to request absences.

We wish all students the best of luck across the exam season and greatly appreciate your continued support.
