We have organised a fantastic opportunity for our Year 11 English students to see a production of key scenes from this play which is part of their Literature Scheme of Work.

The Globe Players are a group who have been touring schools in London and the South-East since 1966. They visit schools with the aim of bringing live theatre to students sometimes for the first time. The 'text study' productions they offer comprise the dramatization of key scenes from the play, interspersed with discussion and analysis to provide audiences with an insight into the classics.

They look at the way in which J.B. Priestley puts his message across to the audience and this will hopefully be a very useful tool to consolidate ideas we have already studied and will act as a revision tool before students begin their mock exams in English Literature on the 28 February 2019.

The company will be coming into school on the **4 February 2019** and students would be taken off timetable from 9am to 11am on that morning. It will be held in the school hall and there will be a performance and then a question and answer session relating to the play and its many themes.
