Minutes from last meeting – 23.10.19 agreed

Roundtable

- Parents' Evenings very professional and teachers well-informed some rooms had lots of teachers so you could hear other conversations – could a maximum no. of teachers per room be established and look at a waiting area for parents.
- o Could the school re-explore on-line booking for parents' evenings?
- Year 8 Options Evening particularly helpful and guidance booklet excellent.
- Information from the school regarding Covid-19 has been very good and students have come home well-informed about keeping up cleanliness. Online learning will be available should the school have to close with shadow lessons for Years 11 and 13.
- o SMHW continues to be well-received parents very positive about this
- Whilst interim reports were viewed positively and easy to access, some parents said they
 remained unclear about target setting and the methods used by teachers to derive current
 and forecast levels CIE to ask CGK to attend the Summer Parent Council Meeting.
- Can Parent Council Dates be published in advance? Feedback from meetings to be given to Parents.
- O School absence line can this open at 8am v 8:15am.
- Some issues around uniform supply from Fosters the school is aware. There is some uniform on loan and we do have the Second-Hand Uniform stock.
- Extra-curricular provision is excellent students sometimes need reminding CIE explained that the school were looking at tv screens with the weekly programme.
- Parking parents continue to drop-off as they turn in CIE to enquire about cross-hatching.
- Toilets students seem to be uncertain about which toilets are open at break and lunchtime and Parents very supportive of the capital project to build a communal toilet block.
- Mental Health provision at Birchwood seen as a strength but parents say that their child is not sure how to access support – neither is the parent. CIE explained that MH referral is currently being reviewed.
- A couple of parents expressed specific concerns about their child's teacher in a specific subject. CIE spoke to these parents at the end of the meeting.

Parents were very positive about the work of PSFA and said that this should be more frequently shared on Birchwood News.

Presentation on the School's Transformation Plan (School Improvement Plan)
